- December 12 (Saving & Self Investing)



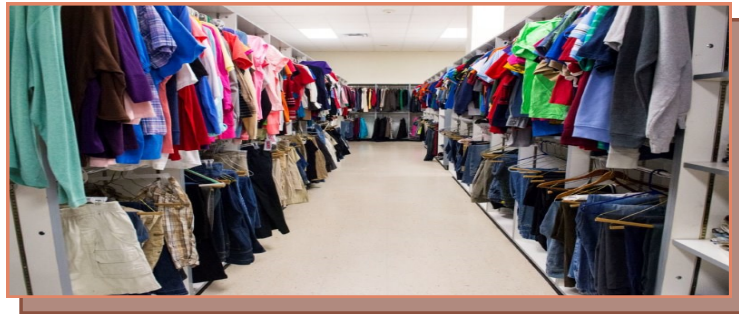
## Probation Orientation at the RRC
